4. Helping others to grow spiritually through life-on-life discipleship

To be a disciple of Jesus Christ is a process that was born the moment Jesus selected His first followers. They spent time together, laughed, cried, and learned timeless truths together from the ordinary occurrences of daily life as well as from instruction. They did life together.

Discipleship must have been extremely important to Jesus, because it was the last thing He discussed with His closest friends before He ascended into heaven. We call it the Great Commission. The heart of Matthew 28:18-20 is for us to be in the process of making disciples wherever we are, whatever we do.

Discipleship is defined as the intentional process of teaching and encouraging a person to be an obedient, passionate, intimate, loving disciple of Christ. It is also described as helping another grow spiritually in the context of relationship that leads to the discipleship of others.

Life-on-life discipleship is God's plan A for multiplying spiritual reproducers. There is no plan B.
