"A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself."" Matt. 22:39

We all struggle with this in some or the other way. Who is our neighbour anyway? In which way are those who work for me or with me my neighbour?

New thought pattern

Let's start with to love someone as yourself.

How much do I love myself?
Can I answer this in all honesty before God?
What would my wife or friends say about how much I love myself ?

How I see myself and how much I love myself compares with how I see my own identity. *Who am I*? Not what my name is or what I do, but who I am as a person. I have a body which determines my sex, tells my age and how healthy I am, but it still does not define my identity.

"My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." Gal. 2:20

"Oh, my dear children! I feel as if I'm going through labor pains for you again, and they will continue until Christ is fully developed in your lives." Gal. 4:19

"I don't mean to say that I have already achieved these things or that I have already reached perfection. But I press on to possess that perfection for which Christ Jesus first possessed me." Phil. 3:12

My true identity is **in Christus in me** which determines **who I am in Christ.** He created me and I am His. He determined the colour of my skin, my sex and what my age will be when I leave this world.

Am I content with that thought? Do I understand that He has forgiven my sins and cleansed me, and that I am His representative. An original and unique representative, not a duplicate of someone or something else?

- Therefore I must ensure that I love myself (with the right identity) in the right way in order to love my neighbour in the right way.
- Therefore I must forgive, because He has forgiven me. I need to do this in order to look at others with Jesus's eyes. (Refer to Gal. 2:20). It is Him living through me. Him in me is the hope and love for my neighbour.

If I want to love my neighbour as myself I need to ensure that:

- 1. It is Christ who is living in me (Gal. 2:20),
- 2. I am happy with who I am (not necessarily with my current lifestyle or position, this can change or improve at any time) (Gal. 4:19 and Phil. 3:12),
- 3. I don't have any unforgiveness in my heart and there are no unresolved issues between me and someone else. No unrighteousness.

"So if you are presenting a sacrifice at the altar in the Temple and you suddenly remember that someone has something against you, leave your sacrifice there at the altar. Go and be reconciled to that person. Then come and offer your sacrifice to God." Matt. 5:23-24

"If someone says, "I love God," but hates a fellow believer, that person is a liar; for if we don't love people we can see, how can we love God, whom we cannot see?" 1 John 4:20

"But when you are praying, first forgive anyone you are holding a grudge against, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins, too."" Mark 11:25



Making it practical for this week:

- 1. Make peace where the Holy Spirit prompts you to.
- 2. Ask the Lord if there are any unrighteousness in your personal or business life, regardless how long ago it was or how difficult it is.
- 3. Prayerful consider who your neighbour is (who you should love as yourself and how you can serve them).
- 4. Go do to your neighbour that which you would love to be done to you.
- 5. Come and testify of your experiences next week.

"Bless those who persecute you. Don't curse them; pray that God will bless them." "Live in harmony with each other. Don't be too proud to enjoy the company of ordinary people.
