On a more serious note. I would like to start off by asking you if you are 100% convinced that God is a 100% God?

Why such a question? If God is a 100% God, why do we not believe and do 100% what is in His Word?

I comforted myself by arguing that I am not God. I'm not perfect. All true, but He didn't let me get off that easily. In my quiet time, He reminded me of the following verses.



"But first and most importantly seek (aim at, strive after) His kingdom and His righteousness [His way of doing and being right—the attitude and character of God], and all these things will be given to you also." Matthew 6:33 AMP

The following questions came to me. Read through them and discuss it in your group. The Holy Spirit will put in your heart what you can work on.

Am I, above all else, striving a 100% to work for His kingdom?
Is He first in my thoughts and in my daily actions?
Am I starting my day with Him?
Am I planning my life according to Him?
When I look at my finances, is He first priority?
Are His commands a priority in my life? (Matt. 22:37-39, Matt. 28:19-20, Acts 1:8)

The purpose of these questions is not to burden you with guilt, but to make you realize anew that we can only be 100% people if we rely a 100% on Him. Acts 1:8 and 1 Cor. 6:19.



"Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is within you, whom you have [received as a gift] from God, and that you are not your own [property]?" 1 Corinthians 6:19 AMP

In the coming week work through each of the questions above and make the necessary adjustments in your life. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you.
