The last few weeks we looked at a few Bible verses that deal with the theme of complete devotion. How did it go? Have you been addressed by the Word of God? This week, we'll look at what Andrew Murray wrote about this subject in the last chapter of his book called *Experiencing the Holy Spirit*.

He uses 1 Corinthians 15:28 as an introduction: "When He has done this, then the Son Himself will be made subject to Him who put everything under Him, so that God may be all in all."

Andrew Murray then writes the following: When we speak of absolute surrender, we are often asked what the exact difference is between the familiar doctrine of sanctification and the preaching of that gracious work that has begun to be heard in the Church in recent years.....the distinction lies solely in the little word all....not enough emphasis is laid on this one point of all. Why then is the fullness of the Spirit not more widely enjoyed? That little word all suggests the answer. As long as the all of God, of sin, of Christ, of surrender, of the Spirit, and of faith is not fully understood, the soul cannot enjoy all that God wants it to be.....be ready to give up everything in order to receive nothing less than everything."
