Jesus' Four-Point Plan for Evangelism

Last week we looked at the questions *What are we doing here? What should we occupy ourselves with?*

Among other things, we referred to Luke 10. Today, let's take a closer look at Luke 10 and learn from Jesus what His plan for Evangelism looks like.

In Luke 10:5-9, Jesus gave specific instructions to His disciples. What are the 4 main points here?

Speak peace, for most of us are at war with the unsaved. We don't like what they do, and condemn them. We show this easily with our attitude towards them. Think of the beggar at the street corner or at your front gate. Jesus was known as a friend of sinners. He did not condemn them, but helped. If He was their friend, how could we be their enemy? How can I share the gospel with them if I condemn them? Most of the time we want Him to destroy the sinners. John 3:17 says that *"God sent His Son into the world, not to condemn the world, but that the world through Him may be saved."*

When we speak peace, Shalom, we break the power or hold that evil has over them. Blessing is more powerful than cursing, because blessing breaks cursing.

We open their eyes when we speak up. So if you want to share with someone, you must first make peace with yourself, and have peace about the person you are going to work with, and then speak peace about the person to open their eyes.

Peace is something you can feel, and you will know if you feel peace in the situation if you have spoken peace.

2. Start making friends. Build the relationship. Spend time with the person. If you are not willing to make friends with the person, rather leave it. In this friendship, you will hear what the person's challenges and problems are. You have to listen with empathy.

3. Pray for the person's problems. Pray with the person for his or her problem or challenge. God wants to answer these prayers because He wants this person to be saved.

4. Share the gospel. At this point, the door opens to share the gospel with the person.
