BZ Acknowledging Man's Problem

God created man in His own image to have an abundant life. He did not make us like robots to automatically love and obey Him, but gave us a will and freedom of choice. We chose to disobey God and go our own willful way. The Bible calls this sin, which results in separation from God.

Romans 3:23 NKJV | "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Romans 6:23 NKJV

"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."



Through the ages individuals have tried to bridge this separation in many ways without success. The only way our relationship with God can be restored is for our sins to be forgiven.


Isaiah 59:2 NLT

"It's your sins that have cut you off from God. Because of your sins, he has turned away and will not listen anymore."

Proverbs 14:12 NKIV

"There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death."

There is only ONE remedy for this separation.



Recognizing God's Remedy

When Jesus died on the cross and rose from the grave He paid the penalty for our sins and bridged the gap from God to man. Jesus Christ is the ONLY answer to the problem of separation.

1 Timothy 2:5 | The Living Bible

"God is on one side and all the people on the other side, and Jesus Christ, Himself man, is between them to bring them together."

Romans 5:8 NIT

"God showed His great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners."

John 14:6 NKV | "Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

God has provided the ONLY way. We must make the choice.





Receiving Christ You must admit that you need forgiveness from your sins and

believe that Jesus died for your sins and rose from the dead.

Ephesians 2:8-9 NIV

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast."

Acts 3:19 NIV

"Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out..."

John 1:12 NIV

"Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believe in his name, he gave the right to become children of God."

Romans 10:9 NIV

"If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord', and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

By receiving Christ you will receive God's gift of eternal life.



Is there any good reason why you would not consider receiving Jesus Christ right now?

How to receive Christ:

- 1. Admit you are a sinner and need salvation.
- 2. Be willing to turn from your sins. (Repent)
- 3. Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the Cross and rose from the grave.
- 4. Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to come in and control your life through the Holy Spirit.

Receive Him as Savior and Lord

THEPRAYER

Dear Lord,


