Dear Friend of CBMC Africa

This edition of the Third Quarter of CBMC Africa Report, we focus on the importance of Evangelism and Discipleship in the marketplace. As I travelled across Africa and visited CBMC teams, it became very clear that we needed to focus on Evangelism and Discipleship. One of the key things we identified first in order to help existing teams to become effective Connect3 teams, was to encourage team members to get involved in one on one discipleship using OT.

During this quarter, we had Vision Casting Seminar in Burundi on 27th July 2018 which resulted in 3 men from Burundi attending the East Africa training in Rwanda. Two (2) Regional Trainings were conducted; Southern Africa Training/ Zimbabwe National Convention in Zimbabwe and East Africa training in Rwanda. The Zimbabwe training attracted 4 African countries namely Malawi, South Africa, Zambia and Zimbabwe. During the East Africa training we had Burundi, Congo DRC, Ethiopia, Kenya, Rwanda, Uganda and Tanzania.

Please join me to pray for all CBMC men and women who have committed to be Marketplace Ambassadors and disciple-makers so that the fire may keep burning in their hearts as they affect men and women in their areas.

My encouragement to all CBMC leaders and volunteers is that we should keep "the main thing". The bible in the book of Galatians 6:9 says
